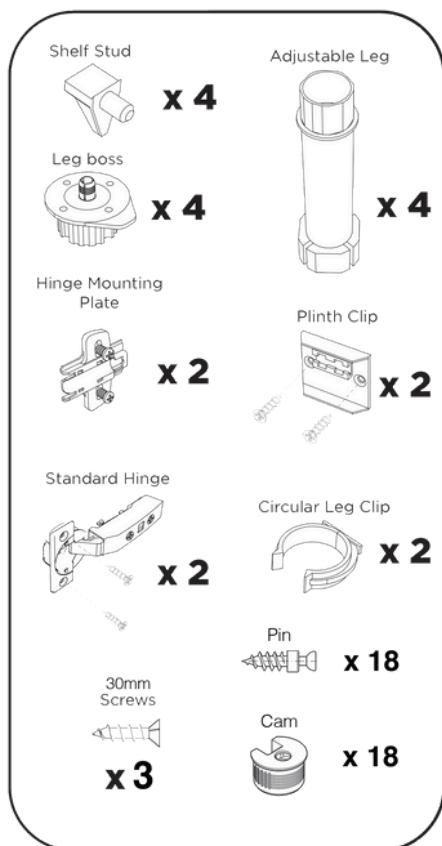
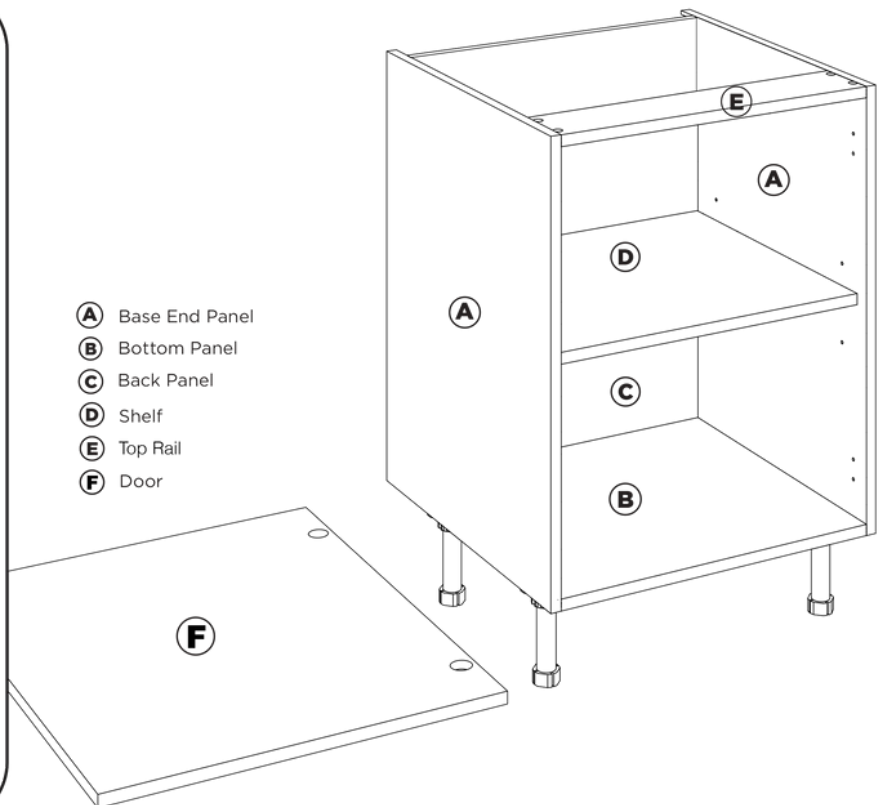

BASE CABINET ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

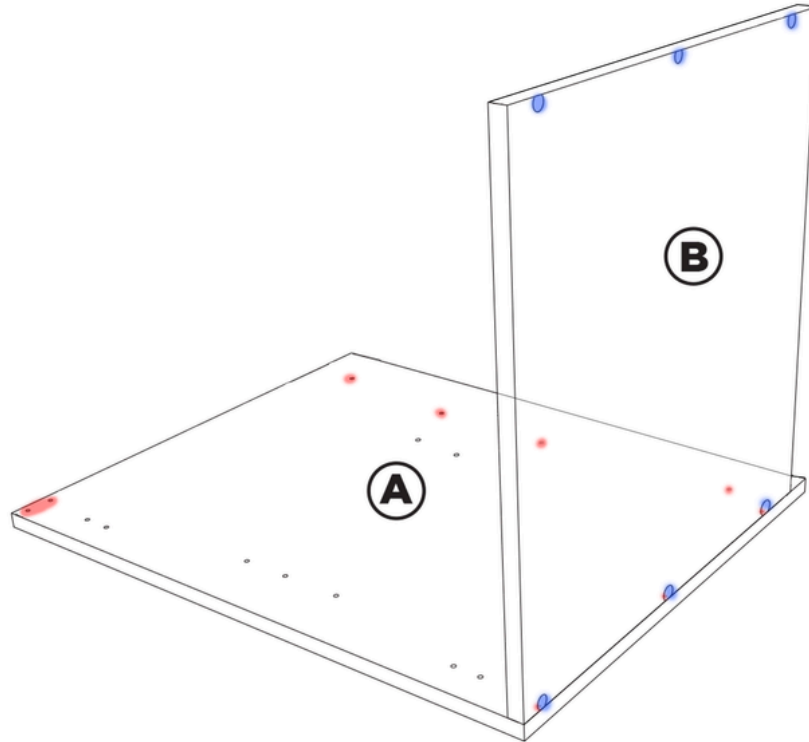


- (A)** Base End Panel

- (F)** Door



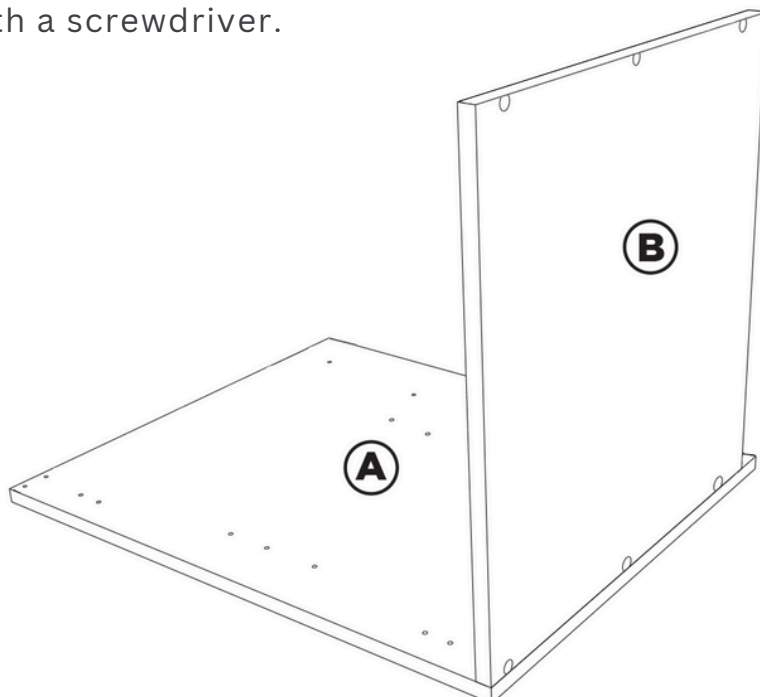
STEP - 1

Secure all highlighted pins (red) into both **Part A** sections. Insert all highlighted cams (blue) into **Part B** and **Part E** as indi



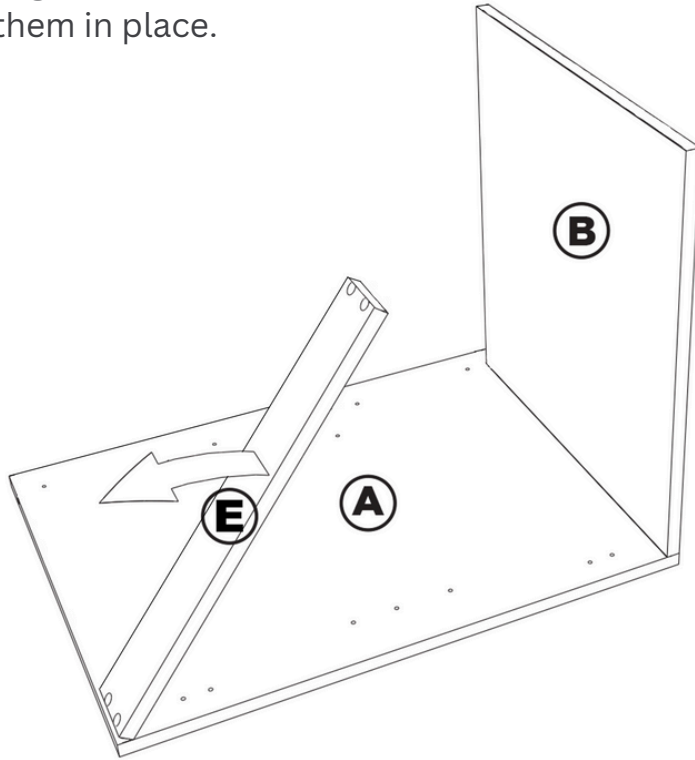
STEP - 2

Align **Part B** with **Part A** using the pin and cam system. Once properly positioned, secure the cams by tightening them with a screwdriver.



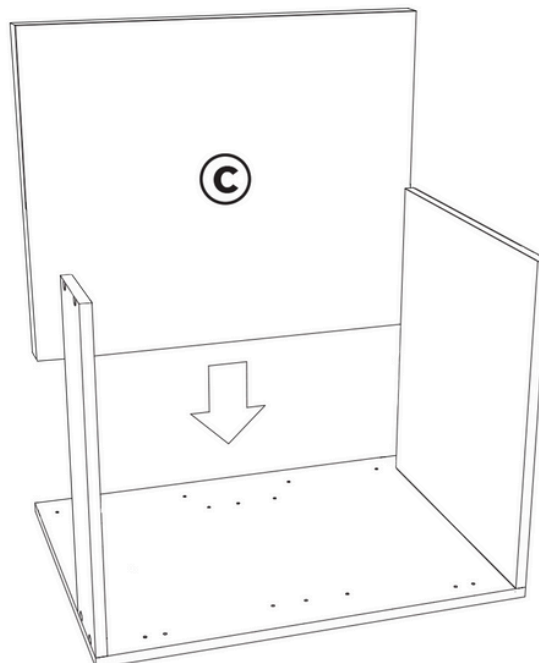
STEP - 3

Align **Part E** with **Part A** using the pin and cam system. Once aligned and connected, tighten the cams with a screwdriver to secure them in place.



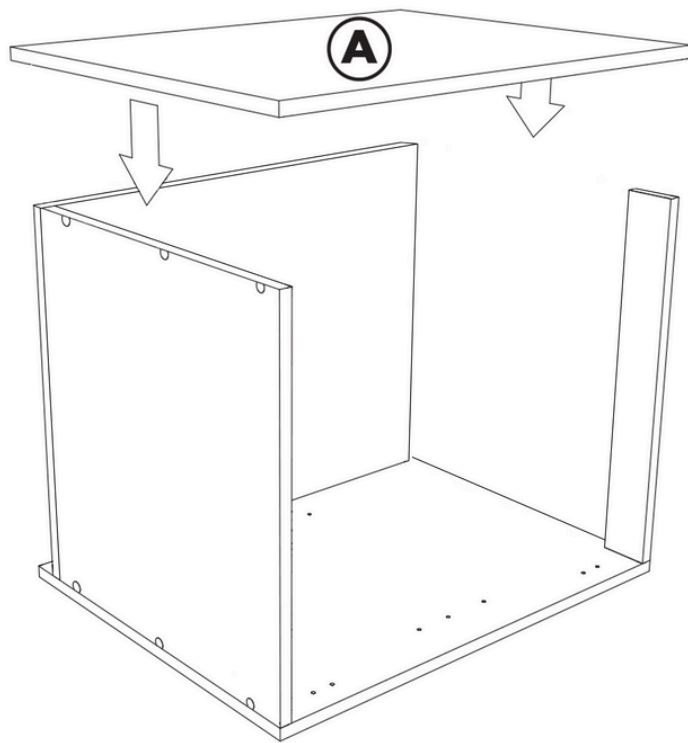
STEP - 4

Align **Part C** with the back of **Part A** using the pin and cam system. Once properly positioned and connected, secure the cams by tightening them with a screwdriver.



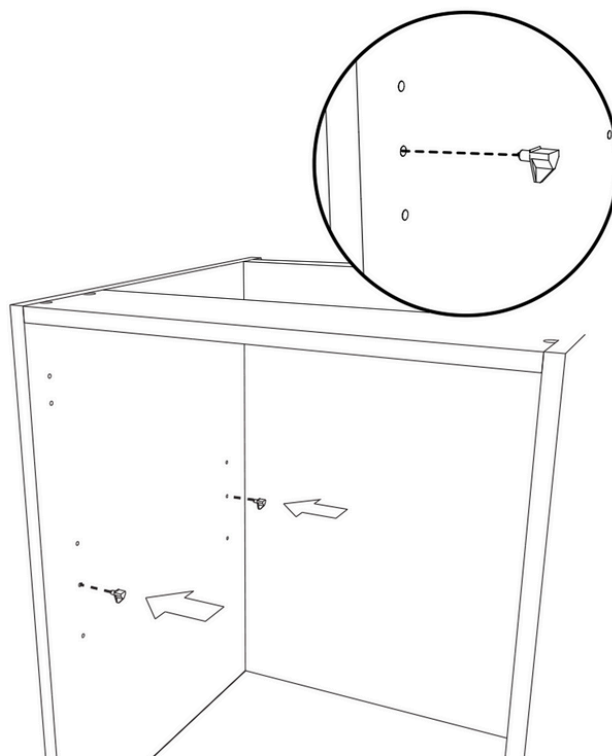
STEP - 5

Align the second **Part A** with the assembled components. Once properly positioned and connected, tighten all the cams with a screwdriver to secure them.



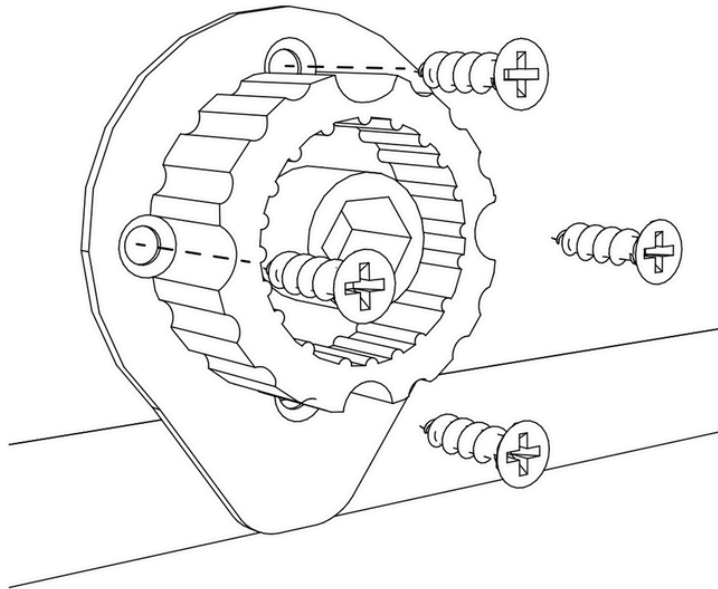
STEP - 6

Install the shelf support studs.



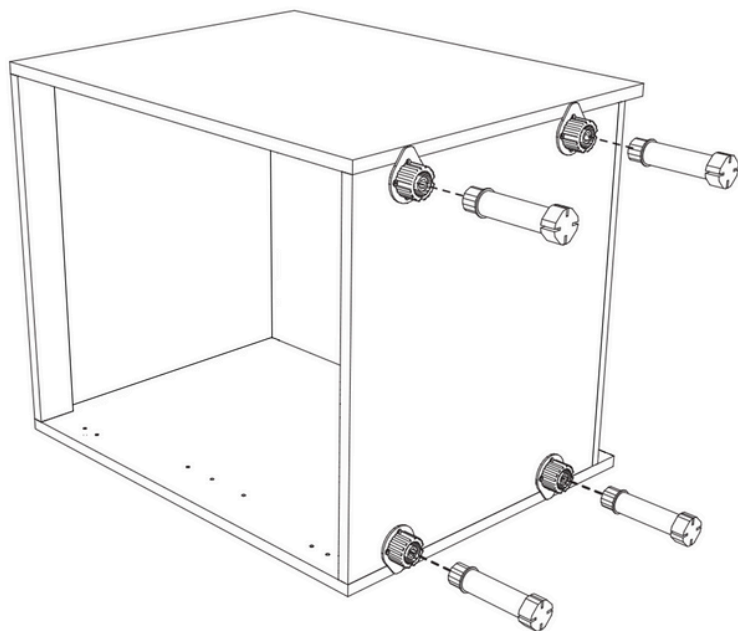
STEP - 7

Secure all leg bosses using the **15mm** screws



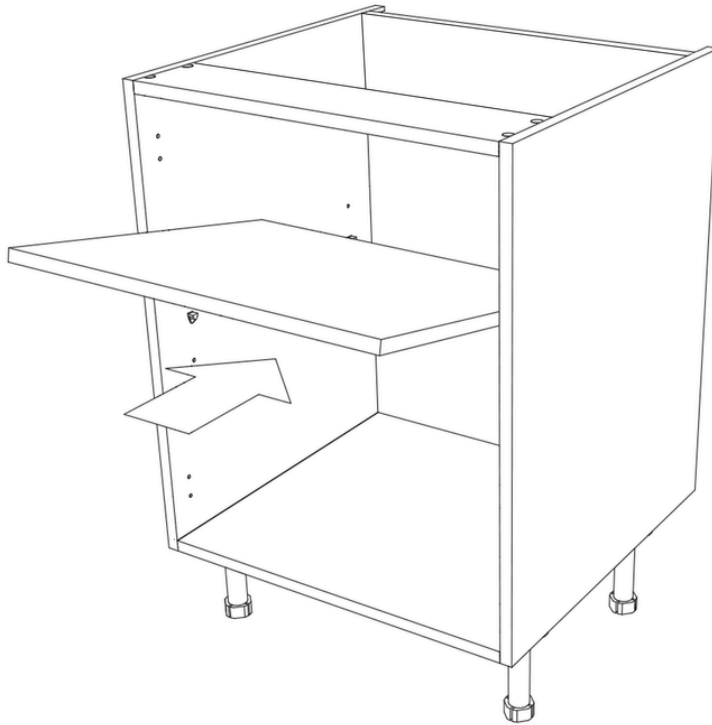
STEP - 8

Attach the adjustable legs to the leg bosses.



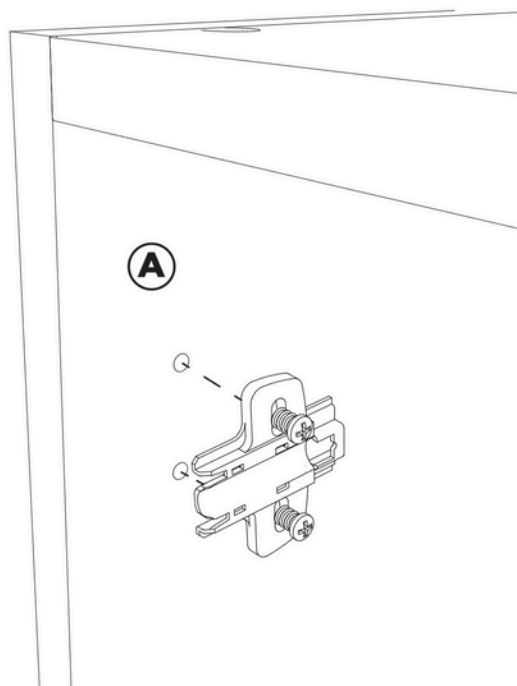
STEP - 9

Install the final **Part E** into the cabinet



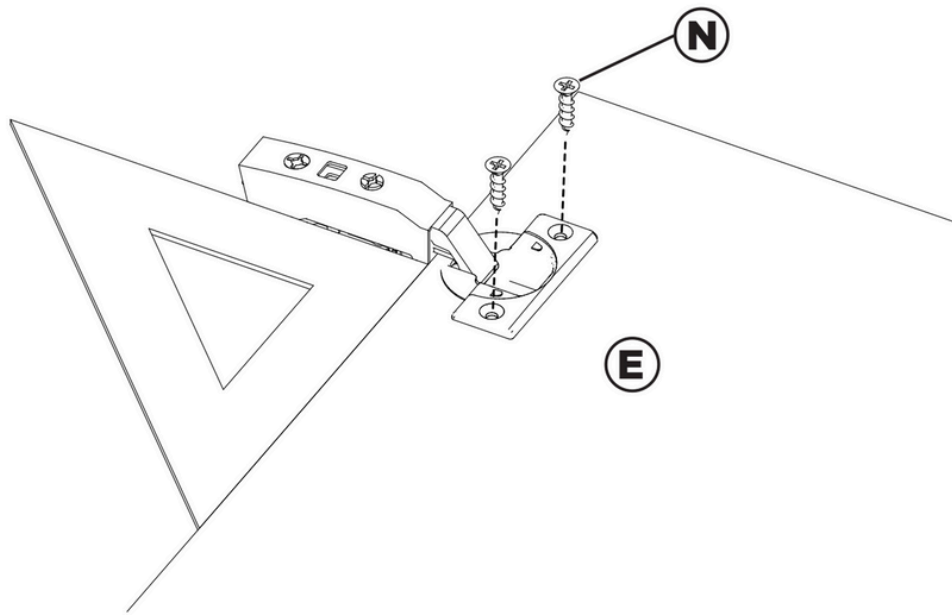
STEP - 10

Attach the hinge mounting plates, ensuring the flat side faces the front of the cabinet



STEP - 11

Make sure the hinge arm is positioned at a **90-degree angle** to the door before securing it with **15mm** screws as illustrated



STEP - 12

Adjust the hinges as illustrated
